## Selected New Testament Scriptures

If you are thirsty what is it that your body really craves, water.

- 70% of your body is made up of water.
- A person can live for about a month without food, but only about a week without water.

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Why do you think Jesus compares Himself to water and food in the Scriptures?

- **John 4:7-14**
  - Jesus crosses the racial lines of His time to engage a woman about her greatest need, not for physical water but rather for “living water”.
  - **Verse #10**
    - The gift of God.
    - Who it is speaking to you.
    - You would have asked and I would have given you “living water”.

Jesus also compares Himself to another physical thing we need, food.

- **John 6:26-35**
  - Jesus begins this section of Scripture with a challenge seen in **verses, 26-27**.
  - Be careful that you do not get deceived and begin to work for the “bread” of the world.
  - Genesis 25 Esau sells his birthright for a simple meal of lentil stew and bread.

- Rather take of the bread that will endure to eternal life.
- These people stand at the door of great opportunity for eternal life and what do they ask for, a sign.
- “God gave our fathers a sign (mana) what are you willing to give us as a sign?”
- **Hebrews 11:1-2**
- **Verses 32-35**

Jesus says He is the “living water” and the “bread of life”, but the thing that rings true for both is that if we drink the “living water” and eat the “bread of life” we will never thirst and hunger again.

### **John 6:1-14**

- Today which one are you a Phillip or an Andrew?
  - Phillip saw what was earthly.
  - Andrew saw what was possible when our sufficiency is found in Christ.
