

## WHAT SONG IS IN YOUR HEART?

Psalm 124

### Who Is Your Tag Team Partner?

When you surrendered your life to Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior, you stepped into a ring, but your opponent was not just any wrestler, for the Scriptures describe your opponent this way.

- **Ephesians 6:12**
- Behind those opponents is none other than satan!  
Bottom line, your opponent is not going to fight fair.
  - He wants your family.
  - He wants your children.
  - He wants your wife.
  - He wants your husband.
  - He wants your life.
- And he will do anything do get them.
- So, what are we to do, tag our Tag Team Partner, God.

I tell you all this to get to our next Psalm in our Sermon Series, “What Song Is In Your Heart” so join me this morning in Psalm 124, for a Sermon we have entitled, “Who Is Your Tag Team Partner”.

Many believe that this Psalm was written in the time of **II Samuel 5:17-21**.

- David learns of the death of King Saul and his best friend in the world, Jonathan.
- David is now King and the Philistines who had killed Saul and Jonathan are now on the hunt for David, the next King.
  - It says that all the Philistines went to seek David (not to congratulate him for being the new King, they wanted him dead.)
  - David retreats to his “stronghold” and as he looks out into the valley he sees a sea of Philistines.
  - David does not say “get your armor on boys we need to go into battle”, it says “David inquired of the Lord”.
  - God says, “Go up for I will certainly give the Philistines into your hand”.
    - Baalperazim – Master of the breakthrough.
  - The Philistines regroup and come at David again.
    - **II Samuel 5:22-25**

See David did not go into the battle alone, he used his Tag Team Partner, none other than God.

**Psalm 124** can be divided into 2 sections:

- Life without God. (verses 1-5)
  - Exodus 14:5-12
- Life with God. (verses 6-8)
  - Exodus 14:13-14

When your Tag Team Partner is God, He will often take the attacks of the enemy on turn it on them.

What have you been battling this week, month, year? Maybe it is time for you to tag your Partner and let Him battle for you.
