

WHAT SONG IS IN YOUR HEART?
Psalm 125
Do You Have Faith To Ring The Bell?

Faith puts God between us and our circumstances.

Luke 8:43-48

- Time could not heal her (she had waited for 12 years).
- Doctors could not heal her.
- Money could not heal her.
- No one could heal her.
- Out of desperation she comes to Jesus.
- **“She declared in the presence of everyone there why she had touched Jesus and how when she did she was immediately healed (testimony).”**
- Jesus says, **“Daughter, your faith has made you well, go in peace.”**

Today we find ourselves in **Psalm 125** as we continue in our Sermon Series, *“What Song Is In Your Heart”*.

- We see that God is the one, in **Job 35:10**, that gives songs in the night.

In **Psalm 125** we see the Psalmist describe 3 different people.

- The faithful (**righteous and good**) (**verses 1-2**)
- The apostate (**a rejecter of the faith**) (**verse 3**)
- The backslidden (**a faller from the faith**) (**verse 5**)

Jesus speaks of all 3 of these in the parable found in **Luke 8:4-15**.

- The faithful – **8:15**
- The apostate – **8:12**
- The backslidden – **8:13**

The Psalmist begins in **verses 1-2** by describing those that “trust in the Lord” to Mt. Zion.

- Cannot be moved.
- Abides forever.
- The mountains that surround the city.
 - Jerusalem
 - The city was built upon solid rock that had been dug deep.

- It is surrounded by mountains as protection from the enemy.
- There were 2 sets of walls around the city of Jerusalem.
- **Job 1:10**

Jesus tells a parable in **Matthew 7:24-27**.

- When we act on the Word of God then we exercise our faith.
- When we do not act on the Word of God, Jesus says we are a fool.
- **I Corinthians 3:10-11**
