

ARE YOU A “CONVENIENT” CHRISTIAN? Selected Old & New Testament Scripture

Convenient – one of the synonyms for this word is actually “ease”.

My question for us today is simply this, “am I a convenient Christian?”

To answer that questions let me pose 4 questions to you this morning.

1. Do you attend Church when it is convenient?
 - Most of us will get up tomorrow morning and go to a job?
 - Why?
 - So, what is our motivation to come to Church on Sunday?
 - **Acts 2:42.** (A Church Living Life Together!)
 - **Psalm 122:1.**
2. Do you serve in the Church Body when it is convenient?
 - We say on our Prayer Card that we are a “ministry driven body of believers.”
 - **I Peter 4:10.**
 - Each one.
 - Special gift.
 - Employ.
 - Serving one another.
 - Good steward.
3. Do you give when it is convenient?
 - Again, if we go back to our Prayer Card, we see that we are a “giving body of believers.”
 - How would God go about getting across the point to His people the importance of giving?
 - **Exodus 23:19.**
4. Do you share Christ with others when it is convenient?
 - Again, if you go to our Prayer Card, we see that we are a “soul winning body of believers.”
 - Is there ever a convenient time to share the Gospel with another person?
 - **Colossians 4:5-6.**
 - ***“making the most of every opportunity.”***

- To truly understand the cost of this table we need not start at Calvary but rather heaven.
 - **Philippians 2:5-8.**
 - Existed in the form of God.
 - Did not see that equality a thing to be grasped but rather let it go.
 - Emptied Himself.
 - Took the form of a bondservant.
 - Was made in the likeness of man.
 - Humbled Himself to the point of death, not just any death but death on a cross.
