Key Verse


JOHN 15:12 (NLT)

Bible Story
JESUS CALLS MATTHEW
MATTHEW 9:9-13

As Jesus was walking along, He saw a man named Matthew sitting at his tax collector's booth. "Follow Me and be My disciple," Jesus said to him. So Matthew got up and followed him.



Later, Matthew invited Jesus and His disciples to his home as dinner guests, along with many tax collectors and other disreputable sinners. But when the Pharisees saw this, they asked His disciples, "Why does your teacher eat with such scum?"

When Jesus heard this, He said, "Healthy people don't need a doctor—sick people do." Then He added, "Now go and learn the meaning of this Scripture: 'I want you to show mercy, not offer sacrifices.' For I have come to call not those who think they are righteous, but those who know they are sinners."

Discussion

- What is the best way to make a GOOD first impression?
- Has anyone ever been wrong in their first impression of you? How did that make you feel?
- What do you think Jesus' first impression of Matthew was? How can you tell?
- How did Matthew show that others' first impression of him was wrong?

It can be hard to take the first steps in making a friend. Remember to ask Jesus to help you! Just a smile can start a friendship—then, as you get to know each other better, your friend will learn WHY you smiled...because Jesus is YOUR friend and wants to be THEIR friend too!
